LOS ANGELES March 8, 2017 - Photographer Susan Brandt Graham of USA was presented with the 10th Annual International Color Awards Nominee title in the category of Still Life at a prestigious Nomination & Winners Photoshow streamed Saturday, March 4, 2017.
